Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan Heritage Architecture Excellence Award

Call For Nominations 2012

The Architectural Heritage Society of Saskatchewan will be convening the provincial awards for heritage and building renovation. Deadline for nominations each year is March 31.

These annual awards recognize the dedication of building owners, the wisdom and skill of designers, and the exceptional achievements of local craftspersons ... everyone who contributes to preservation of Saskatchewan's architectural heritage.

Awards may be made in the following categories:

1. Exterior Conservation
2. Interior Conservation
3. Rehabilitation
4. Adaptive Re-use
5. Sympathetic New Construction
6. Landscape and other Contextual Works
7. Signage, Monuments and Interpretation
8. Long-term Stewardship of a Heritage Property

To be eligible a project must have been substantially completed by March 31, 2012.

These Awards are nominated by the public and selected by a special jury of the Architectural Heritage Society of Saskatchewan.

 - c. Prime Contractor
 - d. Any notable Craftspersons involved

3. Brief History of Building (whatever is known)
 - a. Date of construction
 - b. Original owner
 - c. Original architect
 - d. Original builder
 - e. Chronology of occupancies
 - f. Chronology of alternations

4. Details of the Current Project
 - a. Date of completion
 - b. Description of heritage features involved
 - c. Description of work done
 - d. Particular achievements

5. In 100 words or fewer, explain why this project should be recognized

6. Please supply three or more photographs showing
 - a. Primary elevation
 - b. Detailed "before" photos of work
 - c. Detailed "after" photos of work

Note: These photos may be lower quality digital photos and may be submitted by email. However, should the nominated project be selected for an award, it is the responsibility of the nominator to provide high quality digital photos for publication and display.

Deadline is March 31, 2012
